



2023 Youth Scholarship Criteria

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Etowah Water & Sewer Authority (the Authority) awards three (3) separate \$1,000.00 scholarships and one (1) \$2,000.00 scholarship. Scholarships are awarded as follows:

- Two scholarships - \$1,000.00 each will be awarded to college bound applicants
- One scholarship - \$1,000.00 will be awarded to a technical bound applicant
- One scholarship - \$2,000.00 will be awarded to the STAR Student (the Star Student is selected by Dawson County High School based on the student with the highest cumulative SAT score) Etowah Water & Sewer Authority is not responsible for selecting this student nor does the Authority have any interest in how the student is selected

*Note if the Authority does not receive applications for a particular category as listed above the Authority reserves the right to give the scholarship to an applicant in another category.

Example: The Authority receives an application from the Star Student, 15 applications from college bound students, and zero applications from a technical bound students. The Authority may choose to give three \$1,000.00 scholarships to college bound students. Instead of 2 as listed above.

Scholarship funds will be allowed to be spent on tuition, books, and required supplies purchased at the college or university.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, a **student's permanent residence** must be an active account served by Etowah Water & Sewer Authority and they must be a senior at a public or private school, or home schooled at a residence served by Etowah Water & Sewer Authority.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please Include the following:

- School activities
- Community activities or involvement
- Work activities if you are employed
- Transcripts
- Copy of your driver's license
- Copy of your Etowah Water & Sewer Authority bill
- Two letters of recommendation – One recommendation must be from a teacher, advisor, or club leader (teacher who is in charge of a club you are involved in). One recommendation must be from someone outside the school (for example pastor at your church, longtime family friend, employer, or mentor)
- Essay about yourself
- Essay – Describe in detail how you would prepare a marketing plan for responsible water management and planning for the future.

Note: The essays are a necessary part of the entry. Applications that do not include an essay will be voided.

Judges panel will consist of three (3) retired educators. Judges decisions are final.

The finalists may be asked to come to Etowah Water & Sewer Authority for a short personal interview.

Payment of the scholarship shall be made in the form of a check co-payable to recipient and school. In the event a student is not sure of the school, a check will be issued once a decision is made.

The scholarship must be used at an accredited college, university or vocational/technical school.

If you are chosen as a recipient of a scholarship, by accepting you agree to have your picture published on social media and/or local newspapers.

By signing the application, you agree that everything is true and correct to the best of your knowledge.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All scholarship applications and required material must be received by **4:30 pm on Friday, March 31, 2023**. Applications and/or information received after this time will not be considered.
